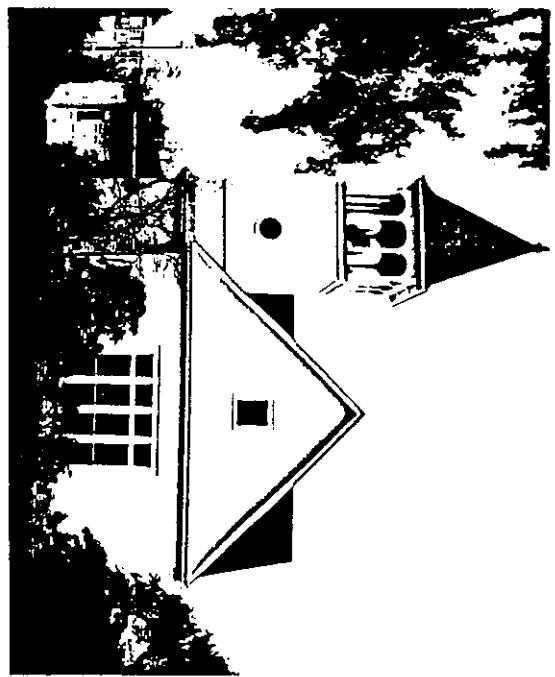

- In the opinion of the surveyor, this property is located in a potential historic district (National and/or local).

The E. H. Congregational Church was formed in 1882 by 13 charter members. The Grow family donated land; the Port Madison Mill supplied lumber; area shipbuilders provided their skills, and in 1895 the church was planned. Charter families included the Grow's, the Parfitts, the Hoskinsons, the Finches, Frybergs, Thompsons, and Garrisons.

In notes of the time, the main building is described, "28 x 24 feet, height of ceiling 16 feet, vestry to be 20 x 24 feet. Also to have a belltower. To be constructed of first class materials, finished in a neat workmanlike manner and cost not to exceed \$1,050.00 when finished."

**Description of Physical Appearance**

The structure is cross gabled with a belltower at the left corner marking the entry. Windows are rectangular casement type. Cladding is horizontal wood siding with a decorative band within the gable. A remodel was done in 1972.
